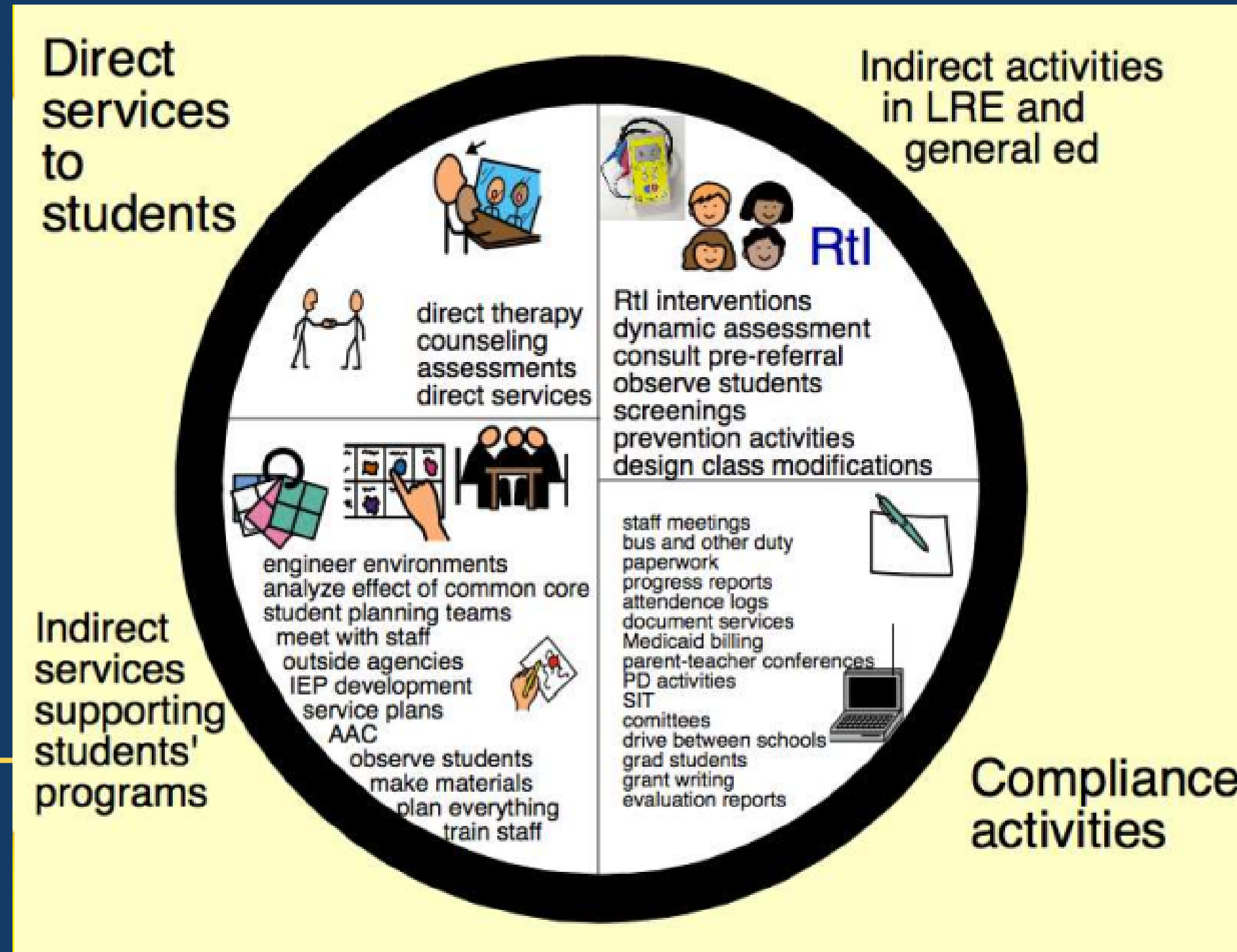

MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports) is important because it benefits ALL students by providing a framework for early intervention and support.

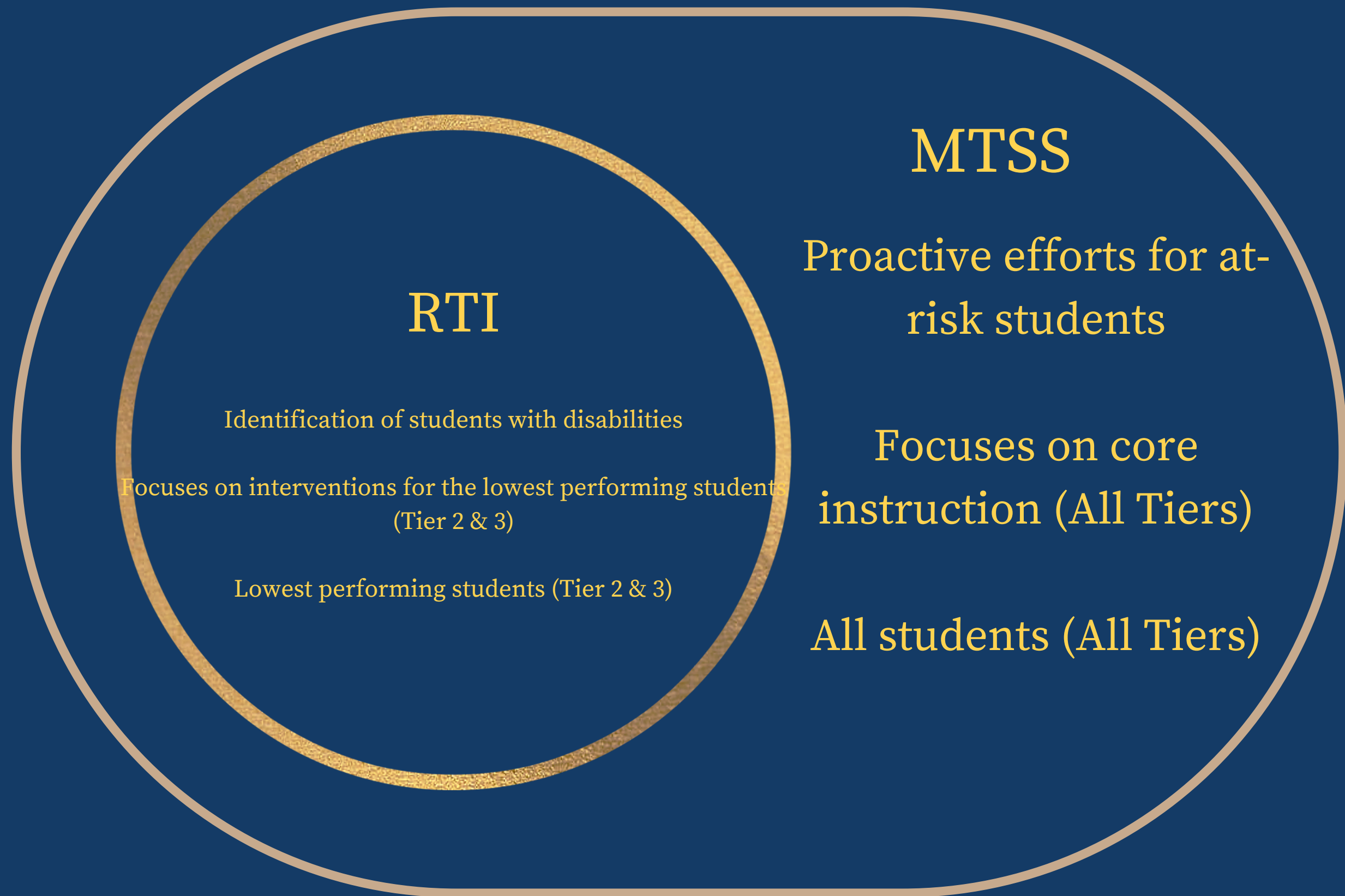


Figure 1-1. The relationship between RTI & MTSS

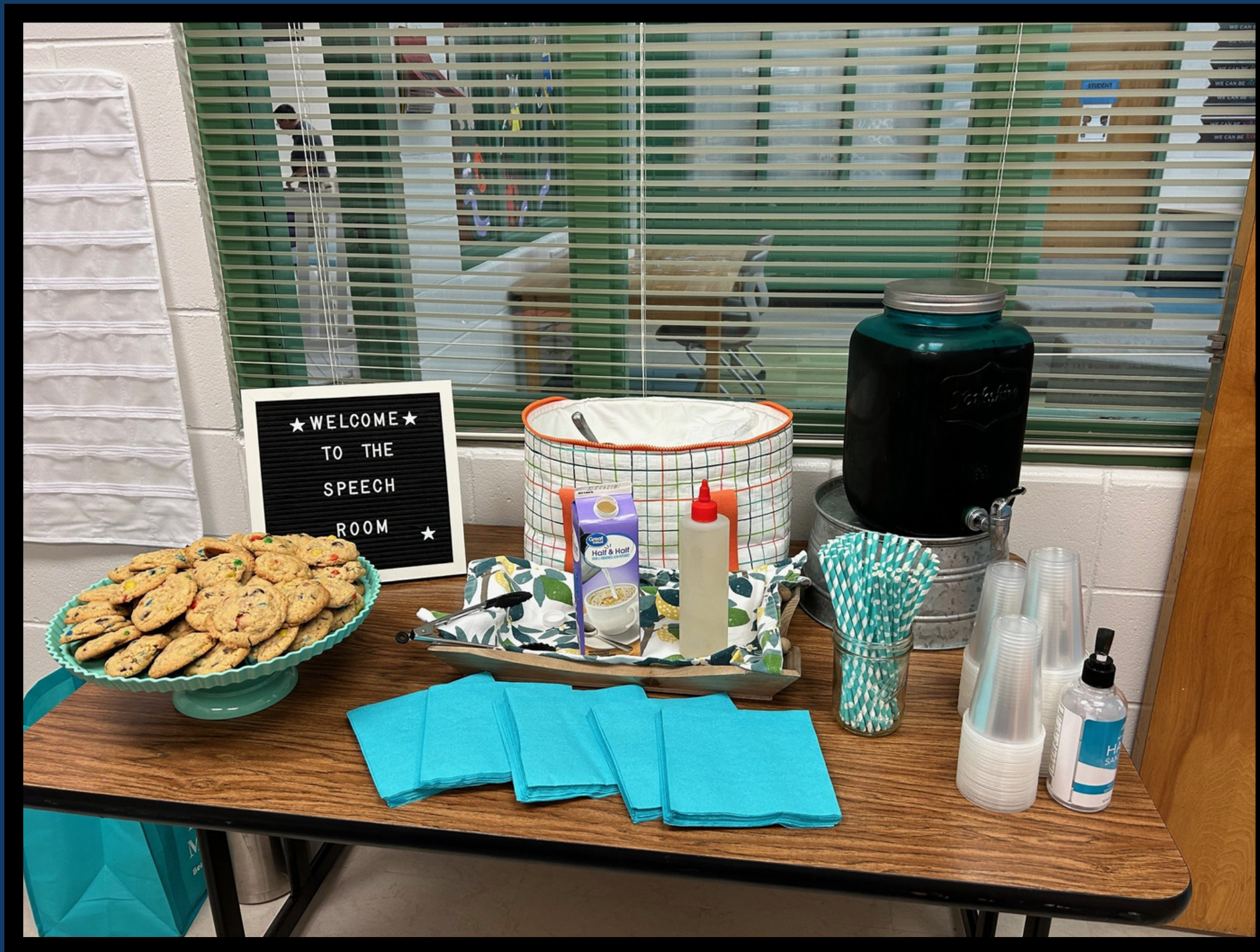
